1. Applicant must be a student from one of the River East School-to-Career partnership high schools: Belchertown, Hampden Wilbraham Adult Learning, Longmeadow, Minnechaug Regional, Monson, Palmer, Pathfinder RVTHS, Quaboag Regional, Tantasqua Regional, or Ware.
2. Applicant must be graduating in May/June of the current year. Students who were Juniors during the 2022-2023 school year who participated in a Work-Based Learning Placement are eligible to apply.
3. Applicant must have participated in, or currently be participating in, a Work-Based Learning Placement (co-op/internship) coordinated through the school.
4. Applicant must demonstrate how the Work-Based Learning experience or other career education activities influenced his/her career choices.
5. Application must be timely and complete to be considered.
